WHEREAS, due to a proposed Rental Assistance Demonstration (RAD) conversion, a significant amendment to the PHA plan needs to be made; and

WHEREAS, the Five-Year Plan describes the mission of the agency and the agency's long-range goals and objectives for achieving its mission; and

WHEREAS, the Annual Plan provides details about the operations, program participants, programs and services, and the agency's strategies for handling operation concerns, residents' concerns and needs for the fiscal year commencing January 1, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Lakewood Housing Authority is amending its PHA Five-Year Plan and including the RAD provisions in its Annual Plan because it was a successful applicant to the RAD Program and intends to convert its public housing to Project-Based Vouchers under the guidelines of PIH Notice 2012-32, REV-2 and any successor notices; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with RAD requirements, upon conversion to Project-Based Vouchers, the Authority will implement the residents' rights, participation, waiting list, and grievance procedures set forth in PIH Notice 2012-32 REV-2 Section 1.6 and Attachment 1B as well as those requirements of Joint Housing PIH Notice H-2014-09/PIH 2014-7 to the extent same shall be applicable (each of which are attached to the Five-Year and Annual Plans); and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held at the Administrative Office located at 317 Sampson Avenue, Lakewood, NJ following a 45-day public comment period and no written comments were received;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the governing body of the Lakewood Housing Authority does hereby resolve to approve the significant amendments to the Annual Plan and Five-Year Plan attached hereto and authorizes the Executive Director to submit same to HUD for approval.
