Employees of the Lakewood Housing Authority are required to use the assigned authority email account for ALL Lakewood Housing Authority business and correspondence. The use of private email accounts for ANY Lakewood Housing Authority business or during business hours is strictly prohibited; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Executive Director shall provide notice of the aforesaid policy revision to all employees.
